This provides a very easy solution for patients, and it is becoming more common. For individuals who need complex oral surgeries, as well as those who are anxious, we offer IV sedation. Even high anxiety patients remain calm and relaxed with the benefit of sedation. Often, they have little to no recollection of the procedure when it is complete.

All dental restorations in our office, including dental implant treatments, are performed with cosmetics in mind. We take great care in the design and placement processes to ensure that your new teeth look like natural teeth. If we are replacing a tooth in a cosmetically sensitive area, our on-staff periodontist will place the implants.
